
Overview of VDSS Child Welfare Spending (SFY19)


Eligibility

- A child (and their caregivers) who is identified as a candidate for foster care who can remain safely at home or in a kinship home and is at imminent risk of entering foster care
- A child in foster care who is pregnant or parenting
- A child whose adoption or guardianship arrangement is at risk of a disruption/dissolution and includes postreunification services










Kinship Navigator Youth Served








Kinship Navigator Age of Youth







Kinship Navigator Caregivers Served






Foster Care Program Changes




Family First- Foster Care Focus





Children in Foster Care


Statewide Total Children in Care, by Month (point in time)




QRTP DFS Practice Changes

These are requirements for all youth placed in a QRTP regardless of the funding source




Congregate Care Facilities- QRTP Status


