Southwest Virginia Legal Aid is a private, non-profit law firm providing free civil legal assistance to low-income families in southwestern Virginia.

How Can Legal Aid Help Me?

Our attorneys and paralegals can:

• talk with you in person or over the telephone;

• help you negotiate with a landlord, employer, creditor, or agency worker; or

• represent you in court or at administrative hearings.

Am I Eligible for Services?

You qualify for our services if you live in:

• Bland, Buchanan, Carroll, Dickenson, Floyd, Giles,

Grayson, Lee, Montgomery, Pulaski, Russell, Scott, Smyth, Tazewell, Washington, Wise or Wythe Counties OR

• the cities of Bristol, Galax, Norton or Radford; AND

• if your income is as low as our sliding scale permits.

What Does it Cost?

We do not charge for our services. There may be court costs or other expenses that you might have to pay, but these costs are usually low. We will advise you of any costs involved in your case.

Legal Aid is funded by the federal government through the Legal Services Corporation and the U.S. Department of Justice, by the Commonwealth of Virginia through the Legal Services Corporation of Virginia and the Department of Criminal Justice Services, and by local United Ways and private donations.

What If I Am Unable to Come to the Legal Aid Office?

Our offices are accessible to persons in a wheelchair. Our staff will travel to meet you if you are homebound, disabled, or otherwise unable to come to us.

What Kind of Problems Can Legal Aid Help Me With?

Here are some examples of the kinds of problems that Legal Aid might be able to help you with:

FAMILY

need protection from an abusive family member? accused of abusing or neglecting your child? told your child may be placed in foster care? need advice on custody or visitation?

CONSUMER

wages being garnished? told your mobile home or car may be repossessed? threatened with foreclosure? sued for debts you can't afford to pay? *Financial counseling may also be available free of charge* through Legal Aid's Fre\$h \$tart initiative, supported in part by United Way of Southwest Virginia.

LANDLORD/TENANT OR OTHER HOUSING ISSUES

having trouble making your house payments? being evicted or locked out? landlord refusing to make repairs? can't get into public or subsidized housing? refused public or subsidized housing because you are handicapped?

FOOD STAMPS/TANF

denied benefits? receiving fewer benefits than you think you should have?

MEDICAID/MEDICARE

told vou have too much income or resources to receive Medicaid? Medicaid or Medicare won't cover some of your bills? denied home health services you believe you need?

HEALTH CARE

denied nursing home care? can't afford to pay your hospital bills? pregnant and can't pay for medical care? threatened with transfer to another nursing home?

EMPLOYMENT

denied employment benefits? can't get paid for the time you worked?

UTILITIES

service cut off without written notice to you? refused electric, water or telephone service? told your fuel assistance didn't apply to past bills?
